Re: <u>Extension of validity of Patient Group Directions (PGDs) for the Community Pharmacy PGD LES provided in BNSSG</u>

We are aware that the PGD(s) currently in use in the PGD service have an expiry date of 28th February 2022.

The legislation currently allows for PGDs validity to be extended for a limited period if necessary.

This letter gives notice & clarifies that the PGD(s) listed below will have their period of validity extended to the date shown by which time the updated versions will be available.
